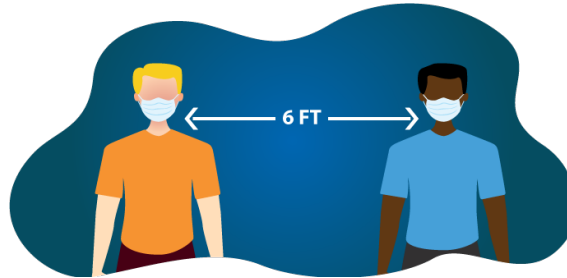

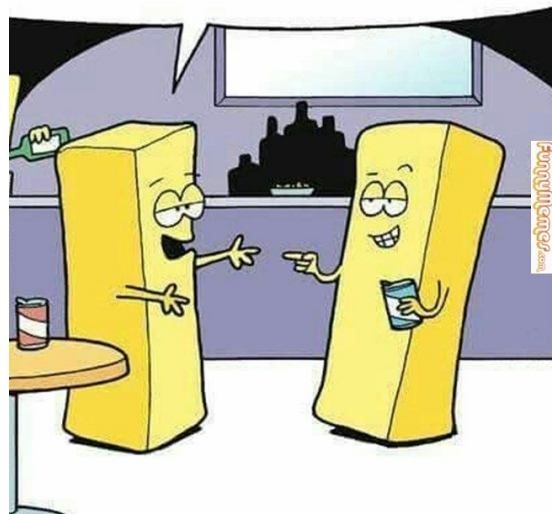
We are looking forward to gathering with you through different virtual opportunities this fall and winter. Please join us!
