

Ordering Deadline and Delivery Changes

Feed My People changed our fiscal year to operate from July 1st - June 30. This means our warehouse has to count inventory at the end of this month and some orders will have to be in early. **If you are expecting a delivery between June 29th and July 2nd, you must have your order in by 8am on June 25th.** Right after our warehouse finishes counting inventory, we will be closed on July 5th to observe the 4th of July holiday. Those of you with a July 5th delivery will hear from us about a different delivery date. Our Field Services team will be making phone calls to all partners affected by the year end ordering changes and 4th of July holiday delivery changes in the next week or so.



Instructions for Paying Your Bill

We just wanted to share some instructions for paying your FMP bill.

1. Please include your Agency Reference number in the check memo.
2. Starting July 1st, all payments will be applied to the oldest outstanding invoice.
3. Please pay according to the "Total Due" on your Monthly Statement. This statement will include the total from all invoices from the previous



Wisconsin Pantries Transitioning to a New Normal


We took part in a state wide phone call recently that included panelists who run food pantries across the state of Wisconsin. They shared some lessons they have learned during Covid-19 and how they plan to move forward to a new normal. We wanted share some of the ideas and plans people have moving forward.

- Some plan to fully open their pantry space for guests to shop. They will put a capacity limit on how many people can be inside at a time.
- Some plan to try a hybrid model to embrace the best of the drive thru option and still allow guests to shop. One plans on offering a certain day for the drive thru and a different day for guests to shop inside. Another plans to use the drive thru for a box of nonperishables and then have the guest park and come inside to shop for produce and cooler/freezer items.
- Some plan to continue with a drive thru model. Their guests enjoy the convenience and anonymity.



Miscellaneous Food By the Pound

Have you tried ordering the Miscellaneous Food By the Pound (DN700263)? It's only \$0.08/pound! It's often food that comes in from food drives or such a small amount of a product that we can not give it its own item number. Order as many pounds as you need. Some partners love the element of surprise and the ability to offer a variety of foods associated with this item.



The Ordering Filter You Have Been Waiting For!

When shopping on the Partner Hub, you can now use the "FA Type" filter to browse through 31 different food/non-food categories. FA stands for Feeding America and these categories are typical across the food bank network. This should help speed up your ordering as you can now just browse the categories that make sense for your program.
